



STARTING A PETROL ENGINE:

STARTING

1. Turn the engine switch to the ON position.
2. Pull the choke lever to the on position.
3. Take the accelerator to low and then give it about ¼ acceleration.
4. Turn the fuel tap to the on position.
5. Slowly pull the recoil starter until the motor comes under compression and on load.
6. Allow the recoil starter cable to re-coil back in then recollect the drive.
7. Holding the frame firmly give the recoil starter a good strong pull to start the engine.
8. Push the choke in.
9. Allow the motor to warm up for 2-3 minutes before accelerating.
10. If the motor does not start, repeat from step 5 (note, no choke for the next two tries).

STOPPING

1. Take the accelerator to low and allow the motor to cool down for 2-3 minutes.
2. Turn the switch to the OFF position and the motor will stop.
3. Turn the fuel tap to the off position.
